Agenda 1: Follow up activities with respect to agenda in the previous BoG meeting held on 17th July 2020.

Decision: Members of the BoG noted and approved the training programs for students mentioning that adherence to TEQIP-III guidelines be maintained and followed.

Agenda 3: Status of expenditure for the period 01/07/2020 till date.

Decision: All the members of the BoG noted the information. The SPA mentioned that institute should expedite expenditure in Academic and IOC heads by making proper planning for ensuring maximum utilization of funds. Also while monitoring training/academic outcome for students the emphasis must be made on quality by taking measures as tests/graded certificates. Agenda 4: Recruitment of one-project assistant for the project under TEQIP-III.
