

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is signed at _____ on this _____ day of 2021

Between

The Indian Society for Trenchless Technology, (IndSTT), New Delhi, having its registered office at 908 Hemkunt Chambers, 89 Nehru Place, New Delhi-110019 hereinafter called the "First Party" (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, includes its successors and assignees of the First Party.

And

The Vishwavidyalaya Engineering College (VEC) having its office at Lakhanpur hereinafter called the "Second Party" (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, includes its successors and assignees of the Second Party.

Preamble

WHEREAS Indian Society for Trenchless Technology, the apex organization to introduce and promote the application of Trenchless Technology, was established in 1995 with the support of the Ministry of Urban Development, Govt. of India. Trenchless Technology, being one of the recent and upcoming subsurface construction technique family, has a very limited trained manpower in India as on date and to meet the surging manpower demands, IndSTT, as one of its core objectives, is conducting several training programmes across the nation.

WHEREAS, under this initiative, the First Party has launched internship, Faculty Development Programs and Skill Development programs for the students and faculties of all disciplines in Engineering & Management, as per Systems and Procedures laid down by the Engineering Council of India (ECI) who have entered into an MoU with All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Min. of HRD, Government of India, for providing "Internship" and has mandated INDSTT to arrange the internships for the engineering and management students in trenchless technology field. Model Internship structure, methodologies, certification system, trenchless technology student chapter processes and systems etc. have been developed by First Party.

AND WHEREAS, the Second Party is desirous to associate with First Party for conducting Internship, Faculty Development Programs and Skill Development Programs for students and the faculties of the College and agrees to send students and faculties to the First Party approved centres and locations for the said programs at mutually agreed terms and conditions.

NOW, THE FIRST AND SECOND PARTIES herein and hereby agree to collaborate for the purpose of initiating, developing and implementing programmes of Internship, Faculty Development, Skill Development and other programs offered by First Party.

1. Construction of the MoU

- 1.1 The MoU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the land.

2. Provisions of the MoU

- 2.1 The First Party and the Second Party shall cooperate with each other for fulfillment of their mandates.
- 2.2 The Second Party shall encourage and facilitate students and faculties of the VCE, Lakhanpur to get the internship, Faculty Development, Skill Development, training and capacity building from the First Party.
- 2.3 Based on the need, First Party may support the VCE, Lakhanpur to design the systems in fulfillment of above and have implemented through the training centers/ institutions/ universities and the industry.
- 2.4 The First Party is responsible for providing the syllabi, curricula and the resources for the programs to be offered to the Second Party.
- 2.5 The First Party shall conduct examinations and issue certificates to the successful candidates trained under the programs.
- 2.6 The Second Party shall inform all concerns that all such initiations and project with First Party shall be treated eligible for utilization of grants under TEQIP and other funds available for the internship, FDP, Skill Development and Capacity Building.
- 2.7 First Party shall have complete authority for all acts and omissions of its staff and / or any persons, associations, institutions and resources.
- 2.8 The Second Party is responsible for creating awareness among its students and faculties regarding the programs to be offered by the First Party.
- 2.9 The Second Party shall develop a system to select the students and faculties for the programs and to send them to the training centers/ approved industry locations.
- 2.10 The Second Party shall ensure the provision of minimum number of interns and the faculties to run the programs.
- 2.11 Second Party will not be liable directly or indirectly for any loss or damage caused to any material or life by the act of First Party or its representatives during conducting the activities during the project period or then after.
- 2.12 The Individual Experts, whose services are required by the Second Party for the project related activities shall be entitled for TA/DA and honorarium as per norms of TEQIP/ Central Government/ State Government/VEC as the case maybe.

- 2.13 For various activities, under the project, the cost and the modalities may be decided jointly on case to case basis under the provision and norms of TEQIP/ Central Government/ State Government/ VEC on mutual basis.

3. Amendment


- 3.1 In case any amendments are required in any part of the MoU, the Parties on mutual agreement in writing shall incorporate such amendments by way of amendments to this MoU which shall be binding and be followed by the parties.

4. Settlement of disputes

- 4.1 The Parties shall use their best efforts to settle amicably all disputes arising out of or in connection with this MoU or the interpretation thereof.
